Quest Beyond the Eagle

The LAAC-High Adventure Team will conduct Quest Beyond the Eagle at Log Cabin Wilderness Camp in 2006. This program was last offered in 1997 and the Scouting community is fortunate that the Los Angeles Area Council has agreed to resume it.

This unique program runs for 15 days (June 24-July 8, 2006), using the Log Cabin Wilderness Camp as a base for numerous High Adventure activities. Its objectives are to improve and

expand the Scout's leadership and outdoor skills, to develop confidence and self-reliance, and to have fun. Workshops, field exercises, peak climbs, and backpack trips challenge the participant to excel as an individual and as a member of a team. The skills to be learned or improved include rock climbing, mountaineering techniques, ice axe use, orienteering, route finding, wilderness survival, and, not the least, teamwork. The challenges include broadening the Scout's horizon and soaring beyond the very heights of the eagle. The Camp is a primary part of the program, located at 9,730 feet on the east face of Lee Vining Peak and over looking Mono Lake.

The requirements for participating are:

- ◆ Minimum age 14 by January 1 of the year of the program; maximum age 18, before July 1 of that year.
- ◆ Be a Scout that has attained the rank of Eagle or a Life Scout who has earned the required merit badges for Eagle..
- ◆ Pass the High Adventure Physical Examination.
- ◆ Be physically able to participate in a challenging outdoor program that is conducted between 9,600 and 13,000 feet of elevation.
- → Be interviewed and accepted by the Quest Course Director and Staff.

The program fee of \$500 covers food and special Quest clothing and equipment, which the participant may keep. Each person is responsible for providing personal items, clothing, and backpacking equipment, per a list to be provided.
