DIRECTIONS TO ACTORS HILL

From the Square in Boonsboro, Maryland, take MD Route 34 toward Sharpsburg. Look for the Huffer Lane sign on the left about one quarter mile beyond Crystal Grottos.

From Sharpsburg, Maryland, take MD Route 34 toward Boonsboro. Follow Route 34 past the third Keedysville exit. Huffer Lane is on the right about one quarter mile from that exit. Follow Huffer Lane to the fork and turn right into the shooting area.

WHAT TO BRING

Shotgun, shells, eye and ear protection. Novice shooters can purchase a limited number of shells on site.

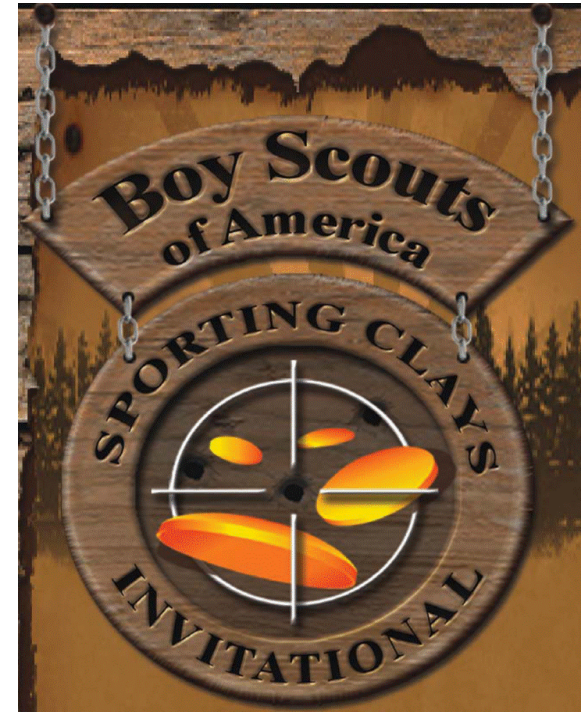
