Training verification can be accomplished in a couple of ways!

1. Provide a copy of your certificate or cards
2. MYSCOUTING account print out of training courses
3. Your BSA membership number allows viewing of just your training records by the Course Director. You will be contacted if courses do not appear or are out of date. *{Not the best Option!}*

NOTE 1: VYPT, SA, SSD, & COS must have been completed **AFTER** 14 September 2012!

NOTE 2: Regular Youth Protection Training **IS NOT** a substitute for Venturing Youth Protection Training!

Courses are ALL available at the BSA's on-line learning center.

How Youth & Adults Can Attend Powder Horn

Adults - Be currently registered at the Unit, District or Council level AND fully trained for your primary Scouting position.

Have a BSA Annual Health & Medical Record, which must have been completed **AFTER** 14 September 2013.

Youth - Must be 16 years old by Friday, August 1st, 2014 and be currently registered in a Boy Scout Troop or Venture Crew.

Must have completed the Youth Leadership Skills Course for Troops or Crews **AFTER** 14 September 2012 & approval to attend by the Scoutmaster or Advisor on the registration form.

Have a BSA Annual Health & Medical Record, which must have been completed **AFTER** 14 September 2013.

It's designed to educate the Scout leaders and youth about specific high adventure skills, through hands-on experiences and to connect them to resources in order to use the skills, and ultimately to get them excited about delivering those skills in a challenging way to older youth.

All older Boy Scout & Venture Patrols within a Troop and Venturing Crews can use all the skills that will be demonstrated.

Powder Horn Recognition

Upon successful completion of the Powder Horn course, participants are awarded a certificate and the silver Powder Horn device, which is worn hanging from the left pocket of any official Scout uniform. Successful completion requires full attendance at both weekends.
