EAGLE SCOUT PALM APPLICATION PACKET

Earning Eagle Palms

An Eagle Scout, less than 18 years old, may earn Eagle Palms by completing the following requirements:

- 1. Be currently registered in Scouting, and be active in his unit for at least three months after Earning Eagle Scout Rank or after earning the last Eagle Palm.
- 2. Demonstrate Scout Spirit by living the Scout Oath and Law, and the Scout Motto and Scout Promise in everyday life.
- 3. Make a satisfactory effort to develop and demonstrate leadership ability.
- 4. Earn five additional merit badges beyond those required for Eagle Scout or the last Palm earned. (Merit badges earned anytime after becoming a Boy Scout may be used to meet this requirement.)
- 5. Take part in a Scoutmaster, Coach or Advisor Conference.
- 6. Earn the approval of a board of review.

After all of the above requirements have been completed, obtain an Eagle Palm Application Packet from the local council service center. Read the *INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR AN EAGLE SCOUT PALM* on page two *very carefully*. Fill in the Eagle Palm Application and the Master Merit Badge List per those instructions.

When the unit leader, or other designated individual, turns in the completed Eagle Palm Application Packet to council, it must contain the following completed forms:

Palm Application Form #58-709 (pg. 3 - only one Eagle Palm for one Scout per form),

Master Merit Badge List (pg. 4),

Advancement Report Form #33403 (only one Eagle Palm for one Scout per form).

Complete the upper left-hand block of the Advancement Report including Board of Review signatures and date of board of review, Scout's name and appropriate Palm earned.

Please note that unit leaders (Scoutmasters, Varsity Coaches, and Venture Advisors) may not sign the Advancement Report and that *only one* Eagle Palm Advancement for one Scout may be listed on the Advancement Report form.

After processing, which takes about two weeks, the Eagle Palm Application Packet will be mailed to one of the Scout's Unit Leaders. *See the Mailing Option section of the Eagle Palm Application form below*.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR AN EAGLE SCOUT PALM

- 1. Fill in all applicable blanks on the Eagle Scout Palms Application form 58-709 (pg. 3).
- 2. Your unit leader must sign and date the completed application form.
- 3. An Eagle Palm Board of Review must be conducted and the appropriate information filled in and signed.
- 4. To apply for your first Bronze Palm, enter the date earned of each of the 21 merit badges you listed on your Eagle Scout Rank Application on the Master Merit Badge List and, where necessary, write an upper case "E" in the <u>Used For</u> column next to those dates. Next enter the date earned for each of the five merit badges to be used for the Bronze Eagle Palm and write an upper case "B" in the <u>Used For</u> column next to those dates.
- 5. Make a copy of the Master Merit Badge List form and retain it as your master list.
- 6. When applying for your first Gold Eagle Palm repeat steps 1 through 4 above on a new Eagle Palm Application form 58-709, and then add the dates earned for the five additional merit badges used for the Gold Palm and write an upper case letter "G" in the <u>Used For</u> column next to those dates.
- 7. When applying for your first Silver Eagle Palm repeat all the above steps using a new Eagle Palm Application form 58-709, and then add the dates earned for the five additional merit badges to be used for the Silver Palm and write an upper case letter "S" in the <u>Used For</u> column next to those dates.
- 8. When applying for your second Bronze Eagle Palm repeat all the above steps using a new Eagle Palm Application form 58-709, then add the dates earned for the five additional merit badges for the second Bronze Palm and write an upper case "B2" in the <u>Used For</u> column next to those dates. For the second Gold Palm use "G2", for the second Silver Palm "S2", and so on, for each additional Eagle Palm earned. It is possible to earn 7 Bronze, 7 Gold, and 6 Silver Palms.
- 9. Be sure to keep your Master Merit Badge list copy in a safe place. An up-to-date copy of the Master Merit Badge List must always be attached to your Eagle Palm Application.
- 10. Most Advancement Records are available for your use in the registration Office of the Council Service Center, 2969 N. Greenfield Road, Phoenix, AZ 85016-7715, Phone (602) 955-7747. Office hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. five days a week except holidays.

Note: When the Eagle Palm Application Packet is submitted to Council, it must contain the completed Eagle Palm Application form 58-709, the completed Master Merit Badge List, and a completed Advancement Report form 34403 *for one Eagle Palm for one Scout*. After processing, the Eagle Palm Application Packet will be mailed to the Scout's Unit Leader. Allow two weeks for processing. *Remember, a new Eagle Palm Application must be submitted for each Eagle Palm earned*.
