Wamesit or Shawshin Indian tribes.**

PREREGISTRATION \$8 OR \$9 PER SCOUT COMPETING**

REGISTRATION DAY OF \$10/SCOUT COMPETING*

There is up to two dollar discount per scout for online preregistration*

***Preregistration closes one week prior to event.**

****Discounts: \$1/scout for pre-registration and \$1/scout if the troop camps overnight
regardless if particular scout camps.**

There will be two main camps (areas) one for each Indian tribe.

Patrols from the same troop will be assigned the same camp.

WAMESIT tribe will be in the High Plains (home team)

SHAWSHIN tribe will be along fish brook (away team)

| 12:30 PM | Patrols cook soup for lunch from scratch |
| 2:00 PM | Continue with event stations |
| 3:30 pm | Competitions and <u>Indian games</u> (Pow Wow area) |
| 4:30 pm | Closing at Pow Wow Area |
