

# 2014 Annual District Recognition Dinner Award Nomination Form



Each year, the Valley District presents recognition awards to adult volunteers for their outstanding service to the youth of our community. The nominee's attitude toward and cooperation with the unit, OA, district, and the council is also taken into consideration. Nominations should be made on the correct form (see attached) and submitted to the Council Service Center before the cutoff date specified on the form. In addition to the information requested on the nomination form, nominations may also include any other materials that support the nomination. The recipients are then honored and the awards will be presented at the annual Valley District Recognition Dinner on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at the Malley Drive LDS Building. The cost of dinner will be \$15.00. Valley District award nominations are due to Ray LaFrance, Valley District Program Chair (see bottom of second page for contact) no later than March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014. ### **DISTRICT AWARD OF MERIT**

The District Award of Merit is a Council award presented by the District. This is the highest form of recognition from the District. <u>Requirements</u>:

A nominee must be a registered Scouter.

A nominee must have rendered noteworthy service to youth.

The nominee should have contributed some type of service to youth outside scouting as well.

The nominee is one who renders service of an outstanding nature on the District level.

Consideration is given to the nominee's position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectation of duty.

#### **DISTRICT AWARD OF APPRECIATION** (Formally known as the Certificate of Appreciation)

The District Award of Appreciation is an honor presented by the District for outstanding service through work on the district level. Applicable persons should be nominated by fellow district or unit peers. <u>Requirements</u>:

A nominee must be a registered Scouter.

A nominee must serve on a District Staff or a District Committee.

A nominee must contribute outstanding service to the District.

#### **OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER AWARD**

The Outstanding Volunteer Award is an honor presented by the unit to a registered leader. Each unit committee may select no more than two (2) recipient for this award. <u>Requirements</u>:

A nominee must be a registered Scouter.

A nominee must have rendered noteworthy service at the unit level.

A nominee must have shown service to youth beyond the normal expectations.

EVERY UNIT MAY, AND SHOULD, RECOGNIZE ONE INDIVIDUAL FOR THIS AWARD!

#### LEADER OF THE YEAR CATEGORIES

(Cubmaster of the Year, Scoutmaster of the Year, Coach of the Year, Advisor of the Year, Pack Committee Member of the Year, Troop Committee Member of the Year, Team Committee Member of the Year, Crew Committee Member of the Year)

These awards are an honor presented by the District to unit leaders who have given outstanding service to their units. The nominees are selected for the highest quality program development and leadership provided in the last year. Some criteria used in selecting these individuals include: quality unit status, training, unit advancement, membership growth, summer program participation, and recommendations of people who know the nominee. <u>Requirements</u>:

A nominee must be a registered Scouter.

A nominee must have rendered noteworthy service to the youth and unit beyond the normal expectations.

#### **SCOUT OF PROMISE**

The Scout of Promise is an honor presented by the District to young men who have given outstanding service to their units or the District through the Order of the Arrow, training, or other means. <u>Requirements</u>:

A nominee must be a registered Scout (or Venturer).

A nominee must be less than 19 years old as a Scout (or 21 years old if a Venture Scout.)

A nominee must have shown exceptional service to youth through leadership provided at the unit, district or chapter level.
