CAMP PROCEDURE INFO

SIGN-IN AND SIGN-OUT

-Each boy must be signed in at the beginning of each camp day. Before leaving, each boy must be signed out. If a boy needs to leave camp early, he must be signed out by an authorized driver or parent. Notify the Camp Director before taking your child out of camp. Boys may only leave camp with those listed on the camp application.



START AND END TIMES

-Day Camp will have an 8:30am check-in time with programs beginning at 9am. Camp will close at 3:30 pm.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is provided by the parents and the pack. Boys MUST be picked up promptly at the end of each day. A permission slip with emergency information should be signed by the parents of any boys riding in a carpool.
