(9716 W. Riekena Rd., Mapleton, IL 61547)

From Interstate 474, exit the Peoria Airport Exit.

Do Not turn into the Airport, but continue south on Airport Rd.

Go about 1.0 to 1.5 miles to the second stop light.

Turn right (west) on Smithville Rd.

Go 3.7 miles to Riekena Road.

Take a left "jog" on Riekena and go 0.7 miles.

Turn left up the farm lane into the Coleman Farm.
