It is an organization composed of Scouts from different Units, and is run by those Scouts under the guidance of selected adult members, including our Council Executive.

As a result of an OA Election recently conducted at your unit, you have been chosen as an eligible candidate for induction into the Order of the Arrow. In order to become a new member, you must go through an Induction Weekend within one year from the date of your election. A significant portion of Saturday is devoted to service projects suited to your abilities.

According to our records you missed our first Induction at Trask and our second Ordeal, in May and September. If this is incorrect, please contact Zachary Johnson the Lodge Chief immediately.

For those who missed our first Induction, Ta Tanka Lodge is pleased to invite you to our Order of the Arrow Second Fall Induction Weekend, to be held at Trask Scout Reservation. This weekend is scheduled from **Friday evening November 30 through Sunday Morning December 2**. Plan to arrive Friday night between 7:00-8:00 p.m.; we will finish at around 10:00 on Sunday morning.

Enclosed with this letter you should find all the information needed, including an event payment form and Lodge registration form to be turned in (with your parent's signature) at the event check in. We cannot reiterate the importance of your filling out the Registration Form and having your parent sign it. Failure to have this form signed would result in your possible inability to continue through the Induction event. Please note that dinner will not be provided Friday, so you should plan on bringing a sack lunch with you. Attached is a list of what to bring.

## **Safety Notices about the Induction Weekend**

Please note that during the day each candidate will be expected to participate with the staff in service projects during the course of the weekend. These projects can be at times strenuous, but are kept within the abilities of the Scouts and Scouters performing them. The Scouts and Scouters may also be performing them in less than ideal conditions. Please keep in mind that although the planning for this has taken precautions for the safety of all involved, some personal responsibility is also asked.

The location of the Induction Weekend (Trask Scout Reservation) is in the wilderness of the San Gabriel foothills. As such, it is home of native wild animal and plant life. Following basic scout practices, camp rules and the weekend's instructions you will be given on Friday, you will be safe. However we need to let you know that there is Poison Oak in areas of camp, including in some of the areas we will be working. Please plan accordingly by bringing long pants, preferably a long sleeve work shirt, and work gloves. We have facilities for showering, so bring soap and a towel. We also ask that you let us know when you check in if you have problems with Poison Oak such as severe allergies or rashes. We try to limit everyone's exposure, but with your help we can eliminate it.

We would finally like to stress the use of sunscreen and drinking of plenty of water during the weekend.

## **Things to Bring to the Induction Weekend**

1. Receipt for payment of Induction Fees (if you have one)
2. Lodge Registration Form
3. Uniform (please wear when you travel to camp on Friday)
4. Warm sleeping bag
5. Ground cloth (no tents please)
6. Warm jacket or sweater
7. Sturdy pair of work shoes or boots
8. Set of work clothes including long pants  
(recommend a long sleeve shirt as well)
9. Work gloves
10. Long handled shovel or similar tool you can use  
(Please mark clearly with your name or other identification)
11. Hat with a visor
12. Sun protection
13. Water bottle
14. Personal first aid kit
15. Rain gear
16. Toiletry or shower kit including towel
17. Flash light
18. Extra set of clothing

Please **NO** matches, food and snacks, or knives

You can also leave your Merit Badge Sash and any metals at home
