CODE OF CONDUCT

To attend this event you must agree to a certain code of conduct. This code of conduct is based on the Scout Oath & Law and the Venturing Oath. This will include all safety related direction and instruction. Serious problems will mean dismissal from the program and the requirement that your parent(s) or guardian arrange for your transportation home.

- Check in begins at 4:30 PM Friday evening. Please plan to arrive no later than 7:00 PM. Instruction begins Friday evening; we are unable to accommodate any Saturday morning arrivals.
- All Firearms must be turned in upon arrival at camp.
- Turn in all medications to the Health Officer upon arrival at camp.
- Turn in all completed Student registration form complete. (Make sure it is signed by parent or guardian.)
- Keep a copy of your **BSA Medical Form and Medication Form** with you at all times.
- Do not leave camp until dismissal on Sunday morning. Before leaving on Sunday, check out with a member of the staff. Checkout will be between 9:30 10:00 AM.
- Be Helpful. It is expected that all participants will help in clean-up or in other areas where their assistance may be needed.
- These are group activities, please participate & stay with the group. Make sure someone always knows where you are. And most of all have fun!
- *Be Prepared* for winter weather conditions.
- Personal tape, CD, or .mp3 players used with headphones are permitted in your sleeping quarters after lights out and before reveille. No other boom boxes, electronic games, or other electronics are allowed in camp. This includes mobile phones, unless prior authorization is given by event staff due to extenuating circumstances.
- Do not cross any roped off areas or enter any of the buildings without permission.
- Keep your sleeping quarters neat and clean.
- A Scout is Clean so is their language.
- Equipment, and especially firearms, are to be returned in the condition they were received. Participants will be liable for any equipment or property damages caused by negligence or abuse.
- Follow all directions given by Hunter Education instructors and other event staff.
- Under no circumstances is anyone to bring any ammunition with them to camp. Anyone found possessing ammunition without the knowledge and consent of our instructors will be dismissed from the class and asked to leave camp immediately.
- Treat every firearm as if it were loaded. Obey all safety procedures. This will ensure a fun and quality event for you and other participants.
