### Special Event - Sink and Swim

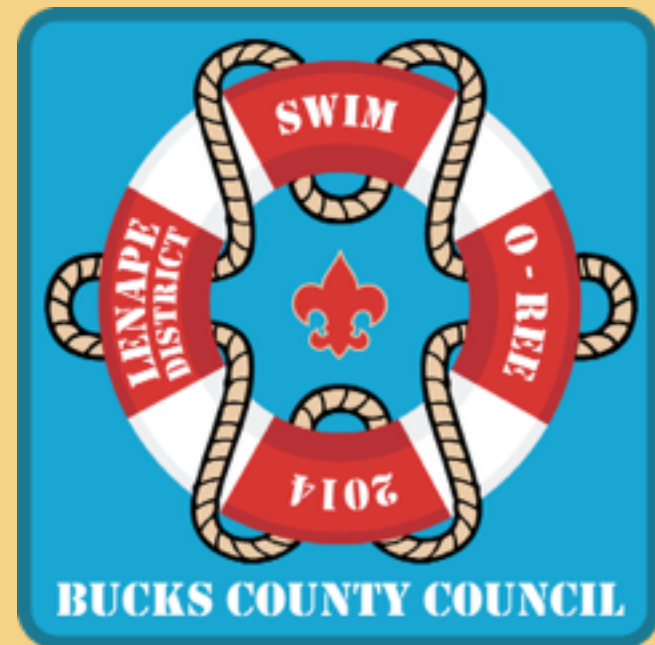

## Rules of Events

### No Diving Rule

(Diving into the pool will cause disqualification from event)

#### King Fisher

- There will be a rope in the pool dividing the length of the pool into two sections, deep end and shallow end.
- We will race 14 and over in the deeper end of the pool and at the same time we will have 13 and under in the shallow section of the pool.
- Swimmers begin in the standing position and will jump in feet first and swim across the pool. The last one out of the pool and sitting on the edge of the pool is omitted from race. This will continue until there is a first second and third place winners.

#### Boogie Board Rescue Relay (6 Man Team Event)

- 3 victims at shallow end of pool, 3 rescuers at deep end of pool.
- First man (rescuer) is to tie a bowline on each end of the rope, after judge approves knots, he will enter the water feet first and swim with boogie board to victim.
- Victim takes one end of rope around his shoulder and takes boogie board from rescuer.
- Rescuer tows victim back to starting point
- Next rescuer enters the water and takes the rope and boogie board to rescue next victim.
- This relay continues until all three victims have been rescued.

#### Sponge Toss (5 Man Team Event)

- Six teams will compete at a time.
- Each team will have 30 sponges and one bucket.
- Each team will have 4 men in the water and 1 man on pool deck.
- Man on deck will toss sponges that miss the bucket back into the pool.
- The object of this event is to get as many sponges in the bucket in 3 minutes.
