I was important in the life of a child.”

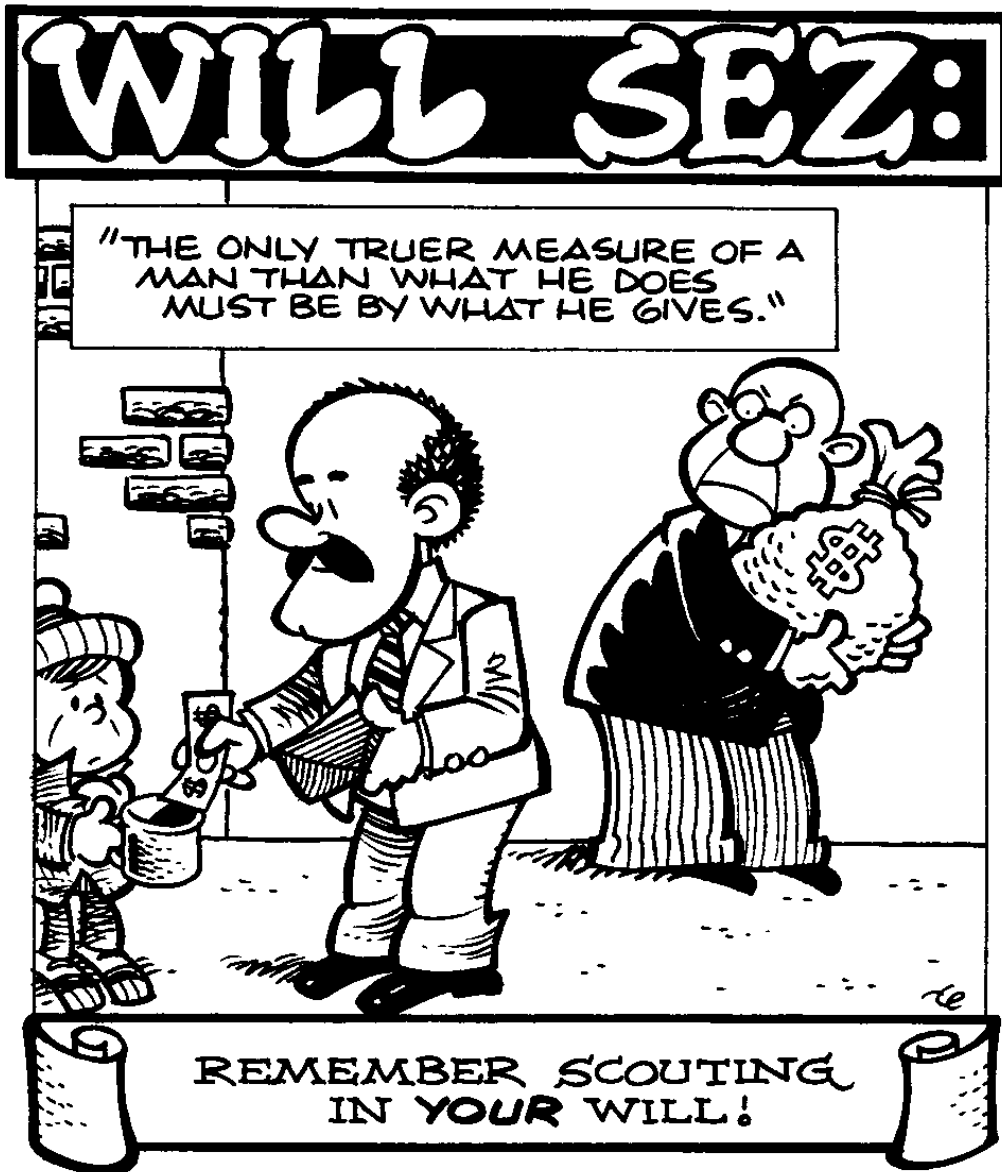
